ORANGE COUNTY, CA, April 9, 2013 – For unknown reasons, the local union elected to picket. We are perplexed as to why they have elected to picket given that we are unaware of any disputes with this specific local union.

We remain committed to providing exceptional services to our cities and customers. Their needs are our highest priority, and we are doing all that we can to minimize any service disruptions during this time. We are working on operational contingency plans in an effort to restore service to customers as quickly as possible.

At this time, we anticipate that we will be able to provide limited services to our commercial customers served by our Anaheim operations, which are the cities of Anaheim, Brea, Chino Hills, Fullerton, Garden Grove, Placentia, Yorba Linda and Villa Park. There will be no residential service in these cities on Tuesday, April 9th.

We are reminding customers that we are prioritizing and working around the clock to restore the regular collection by bringing in help from other areas and using management personnel to service routes on an interim basis.

If we miss your normal pick-up, please store and bag your extra trash in plastic garbage bags and put it out on your next regularly scheduled collection day.
