This unique "service learning" program is designed to build and develop the leadership skills needed to become an exceptional peer leader and mentor. The P.L.A.Y. leaders are responsible for assisting our paid staff, and instructing activities for school-aged children (5-12) at any of the six program locations listed. In addition to their service, our staff advisors provide opportunities for your teen to express themselves through activities that encourage team-building, leadership, and decision making. P.L.A.Y. Leaders also receive additional training and development opportunities with our paid staff, a volunteer staffshirt, and a Certification of Participation upon completion of their commitment.

Registration: Volunteer opportunities are limited. Candidates applying for a position will be invited for an oral interview. Those candidates receiving passing scores will be placed on the eligibility list for 16 anticipated positions. Applications must be submitted by Friday, June 3, 2011. Applications may be picked up at Fullerton City Hall, Parks and Recreation Department (basement floor). Teens will need additional money to buy snacks or souvenirs on all of the scheduled excursions.
